Special traffic controls will be in effect in the Downtown, Kakaako and Ala Moana areas for The 2024 King's Runner 10K on Sunday, March 3, 2024.



Sunday, March 3



1:00AM - 10:00AM

Beginning at 5:00 AM, one or more lanes will be closed and/or coned until the athletes complete that section of the course. Roadways will be progressively opened as the athletes clear each area. Tow-Away zones are in effect from 1:00 AM until 10:00 AM Sunday.

The King's Runner 10K starts at Thomas Square at 6:45 AM.

THE KING'S RUNNER 10K ROUTE

The route runs westbound along S. King Street to Punchbowl Street, **LEFT** onto Punchbowl Street, **LEFT** onto Pohukaina Street, **RIGHT** onto Cooke Street, cross Ala Moana Boulevard, **RIGHT** onto Ilalo Street, **LEFT** onto Keawe Street, then straight into

Kakaako Waterfront Park (Ewa end), runners will run along the waterfront promenade and exit onto Ahi Street, **RIGHT** on Ward Street extension, **RIGHT** on Ala Moana Boulevard, enter Ala Moana Beach Park past the tennis courts to the turnaround at the high point, then past the tennis courts turn **RIGHT** into the keyhole, around the keyhole, exit and turn **RIGHT** back onto the beach road. **LEFT** onto Ala Moana Blvd., **LEFT** onto Ward Street extension which turns into Ilalo Street, **RIGHT** onto Cooke Street, cross Ala Moana Boulevard, **LEFT** on Pohukaina Street, **RIGHT** on South Street, **RIGHT** on S. King Street, **LEFT** on Victoria Street and the Finish Line.

Estimated Opening Times

- 5:00AM - 10:00AM** **Victoria Street** from Beretania Street to S. Kings Street will be down to one lane from 5:00AM. Should be back to normal approximately 10:00AM.
- 5:00AM - 9:00AM** **S. King Street** from Victoria Street to Punchbowl Street will have 2 right lanes closed from 5:00AM. Ala Moana Boulevard, should be re-opened at approximately 9:00AM.
- 5:00AM - 7:30AM** **Punchbowl Street** to Pohukaina Street will have 2 left lanes closed from 5:00AM - 7:30AM.
- 5:00AM - 8:00AM** **Pohukaina Street** to Keawe Street will be contra-flowed to South Street from 5:00AM - 8:00AM.
- 5:00AM - 8:30AM** **Cooke Street** to Ala Moana Boulevard from Pohukaina Street closed in both directions from 5:00AM - 8:30AM.
- 5:00AM - 8:30AM** **Cooke Street** to Ilalo in both directions from Ala Moana Boulevard to Ilalo from 5:00AM - 8:30AM.
- 5:00AM - 8:30AM** **Ahui Street** to Ilalo will be closed to Waterfront Park from 5:00AM - 8:30AM.
- 5:00AM - 8:30AM** **Ahui Street** to Ward Avenue Extension to Ward Avenue east side will be closed from 5:00AM - 8:30AM.
- 5:00AM - 9:00AM** **Ward Avenue** to Ala Moana Beach Park Ewa Entrance 2 lanes east bound will be closed from 5:00AM - 9:00AM.

Some bus routes will be canceled and/or detoured. Bus riders may call TheBUS or visit the Oahu Transit Services website for details.
